## More convenience in the new building

### Area for communication and open exchange

Raiffeisenbank, which has its headquarters in Seefeld, is a bank that attaches great importance to ensuring closeness to its customers and employee motivation. As a result of its regional and sustainable commitment, the bank creates a basis of trust that contributes to a lifelong partnership with its customers.

When renovating the main branch in Seefeld, the aim was to create a place where both customers and employees feel comfortable. In addition to a modern design, functionality and security were paramount.

### Design and function has to be in harmony

The greatest challenge when looking for a suitable service provider of an access control system in and to the building was that the components would be able harmoniously match the overall visual concept while creating added value for users at the same time. The goal was to do without any keys in the future. It was also necessary to take into consideration the need to secure sensitive areas.

Moreover, the customer was looking for a software solution that would allow access rights to be blocked quickly and easily in the event that an employee quit working and that would ensure the easy recording and management of personal data for time management.

In order to keep the administrative effort to a minimum for users, the objective was to find a vendor who could meet the requirements for access control and time recording in a single integrated system solution.

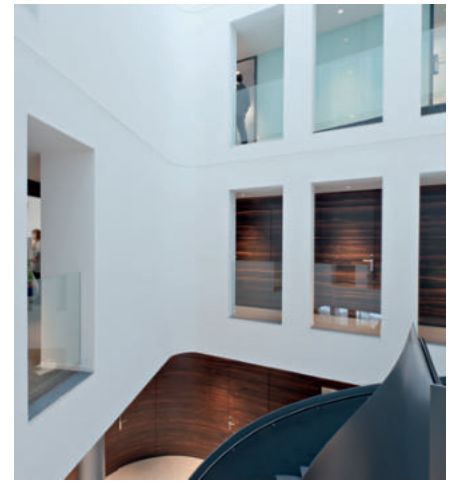
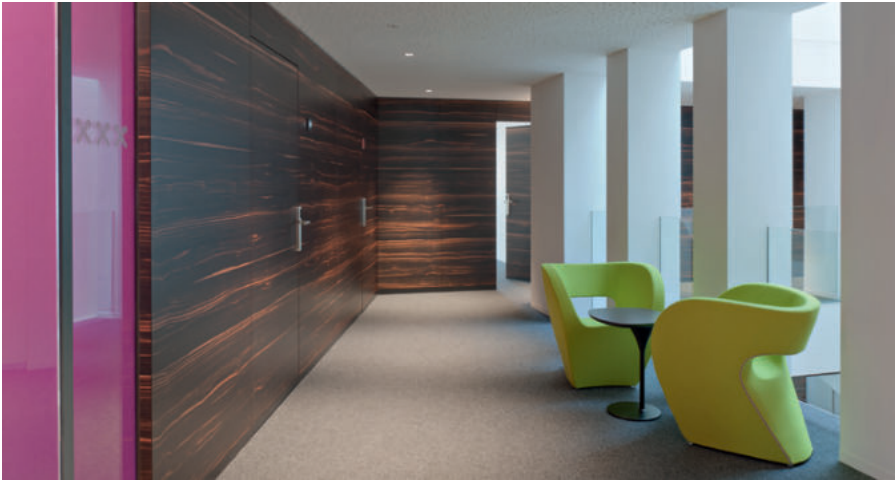

## Many requirements but only one system

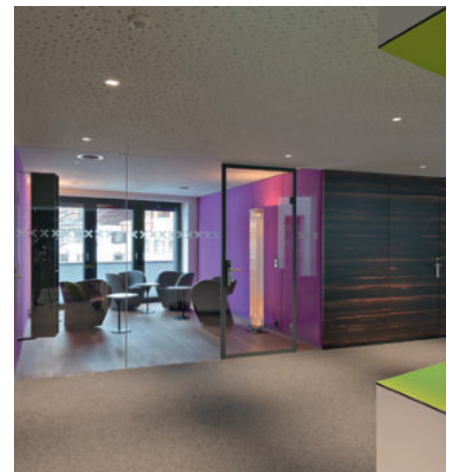
The greatest hurdle was finding a lock system that did not require a key and which did not conflict with the design concept. To this end, a substructure was developed that would allow attractive door fittings to be easily integrated with them.

With these door fittings, it is now possible to individually determine who has access to each room and when. The doors are opened using RFID-based credentials, provided that the card holder has the requisite authorization. Access rights are simply assigned in the system and the RFID cards are configured in such a way that the respective rights are transferred directly to the cards.

Another advantage offered by the Interflex solution is the ability to easily integrate the existing alarm system into the new security system. Coupling prevents unauthorized persons from accessing any monitored areas equipped with alarms.

The time data are recorded using a stationary computer and transferred to the same system, in which the access authorizations are managed. The personal data that employees can manage on their own using Employee Self-service are stored here.

Thanks to the integrated solution from Interflex, the Raiffeisenbank Seefeld not only controls access to and in the building, but also time management with absences such as vacation requests from employees as well as personnel schedules can be easily and quickly processed.
